# COMMUNITY SUPPORT VOLUNTEER (CSV)

## Role Description

**Thank you for your interest in volunteering with Animal FoodBank UK.** Our Community Support Volunteers help us provide emergency pet food support to people experiencing hardship across England, Scotland and Wales.

Volunteering is flexible. You are not expected to be available all the time, and you can choose when you are able to help.

## About the Role

As a Community Support Volunteer, you may help Animal FoodBank UK by:

- Delivering pet food to approved service users in your local area
- Collecting donated pet food from supporters or collection points
- Helping distribute posters and information locally
- Identifying possible new pet food donation or collection points
- Supporting us at events and community stalls
- Sharing Animal FoodBank UK information on social media
- Helping raise awareness of our work in your community

You do not have to take part in every activity. We want volunteering to fit around your own availability and circumstances.

## How Local Pet Food Support Works

Our volunteers use two dedicated Messenger groups:

### Postcode Group

This group is used when we need help in a particular postcode area. Admins will post the area where support is required. You only need to respond if you are available and able to help.

If you volunteer for a request, an admin will contact you privately with the information you need.

### Volunteer Chat Group

This is our general volunteer space for questions, updates, information and keeping in touch with the team.

Requests for service-user support will only be posted by authorised Animal FoodBank UK admins.

## Delivering Pet Food

We will not normally ask a Community Support Volunteer to travel more than 5 miles to complete a delivery.

Where possible, donated food will be used. If suitable donated food is not available, there may occasionally be circumstances where we ask a volunteer to purchase specific pet food from an agreed shop such as Aldi.

Where this has been agreed in advance:

- Keep your receipt
- Send a photograph of the receipt to the admin you are working with
- Animal FoodBank UK will reimburse the agreed purchase by bank transfer
- Take a photograph of the pet food purchased for our records
- Let the admin know once the food has been delivered

**Important:** Volunteers will never be expected to purchase food without prior agreement from an Animal FoodBank UK admin.

## Other Ways You Can Help

- Collecting pet food donations
- Helping at events and fundraising activities
- Distributing posters and awareness materials
- Finding potential new donation or collection points
- Sharing our posts and helping raise awareness online
- Supporting other suitable local activities when opportunities arise

## What We Ask From Our Volunteers

- Be kind, respectful and non-judgemental
- Treat service users and fellow volunteers with dignity
- Communicate clearly with the admin team
- Follow Animal FoodBank UK guidance and procedures
- Only offer to help when you are genuinely available
- Handle donations and purchases responsibly
- Respect the confidentiality of the people we support
- Represent Animal FoodBank UK positively within their community

## If You Are Currently Receiving Support From Us

If you are currently receiving pet food support from Animal FoodBank UK, we may ask you to wait before taking on some Community Support Volunteer duties.

On rare occasions, volunteers may be asked to purchase food before reimbursement, and we do not want volunteering to place additional financial pressure on anyone experiencing hardship.

Please speak to our team and we will be happy to discuss other ways you may be able to get involved.
